Steve Whittall thanked the committee and membership for their continued support during 2017.

Minutes of the 2016 annual general meeting:

The 2016 minutes were issued to the meeting, and agreed to be a true and accurate record.

Treasurer's report:

- BP presented the accounts that showed a profit in 2017 due to the reduced capital expenditure during the year.
- BP Annual membership proposal was to stay the same at £70/£40/£20/£5. (Full/Student/Junior/Social).
- OF counter proposal of removal of the student membership due to continued abuse. Via discussion it was agreed that the **student membership** stays, but only on presentation of a valid **NUS card**. This was accepted by the membership.
- An added amendment was agreed. Annual subscriptions will increase to £80 if not paid by 30th April 2017. This was accepted by the membership.
- BP proposed Match fees to stay the same. £8/£5.
- OF counter proposal was for match fees to be reduced to a flat £5 for Sunday games. Idea behind this was to encourage Sunday participation, and to show a difference in quantity of Sunday versus Saturday games. This was accepted by the membership.

Secretary's Report:

- TF highlighted that some members were not paying their match fees, and the captain was making up the difference so the club was not out of pocket. This practice WILL BE STOPPED.
- TF confirmed that the 2017 was the worst for communication between captains during selection and needs to be improved for 2018.
- TF was very disappointed with the ticket sales for the annual presentation which stands at only 12.
- The WCL will change dramatically in 2019 when the Birmingham league reverts to only two divisions (Premier and One). The Birmingham league 2nd XI divisions will be removed, so at present 18 teams would be amalgamated into the WCL structure. (6 x 1st teams & 12 2nd teams)
- If elected the committee will do newspaper advertising and mail shots to improve club membership.
