



## **Bronze Cricket Club Match Day Method of Working**

### **Prior to Match**

- Seating will be placed in segregated areas on the outfield for both teams and officials
- Seating will be placed on patio for patrons in accordance with Risk Assessment BCC/RA03x2  
This will be 2 tables each with 4 chairs placed at maximum distance from each other and away from the central thoroughfare to the main door and home changing room door. Each table can have up to 6 chairs if required and can be done whilst maintaining social distancing
- Marquee will be erected on outfield for use by Match Officials in inclement weather
- Wickets will be made, and sanitised bails provided for officials unless they want to provide their own
- Contact details will be collected for all parties involved in the match by the Game Day Manager in line with WCCL protocol and kept for 21 days
- Changing Rooms are now allowed to be open whilst social distancing can be maintained
- Only 6 people will be allowed into either changing at any one time. Bags can be stored in the changing rooms.
- Shower facilities will not be accessible at this time. When they are, only 1 person shall be allowed to shower at a time

### **During Match**

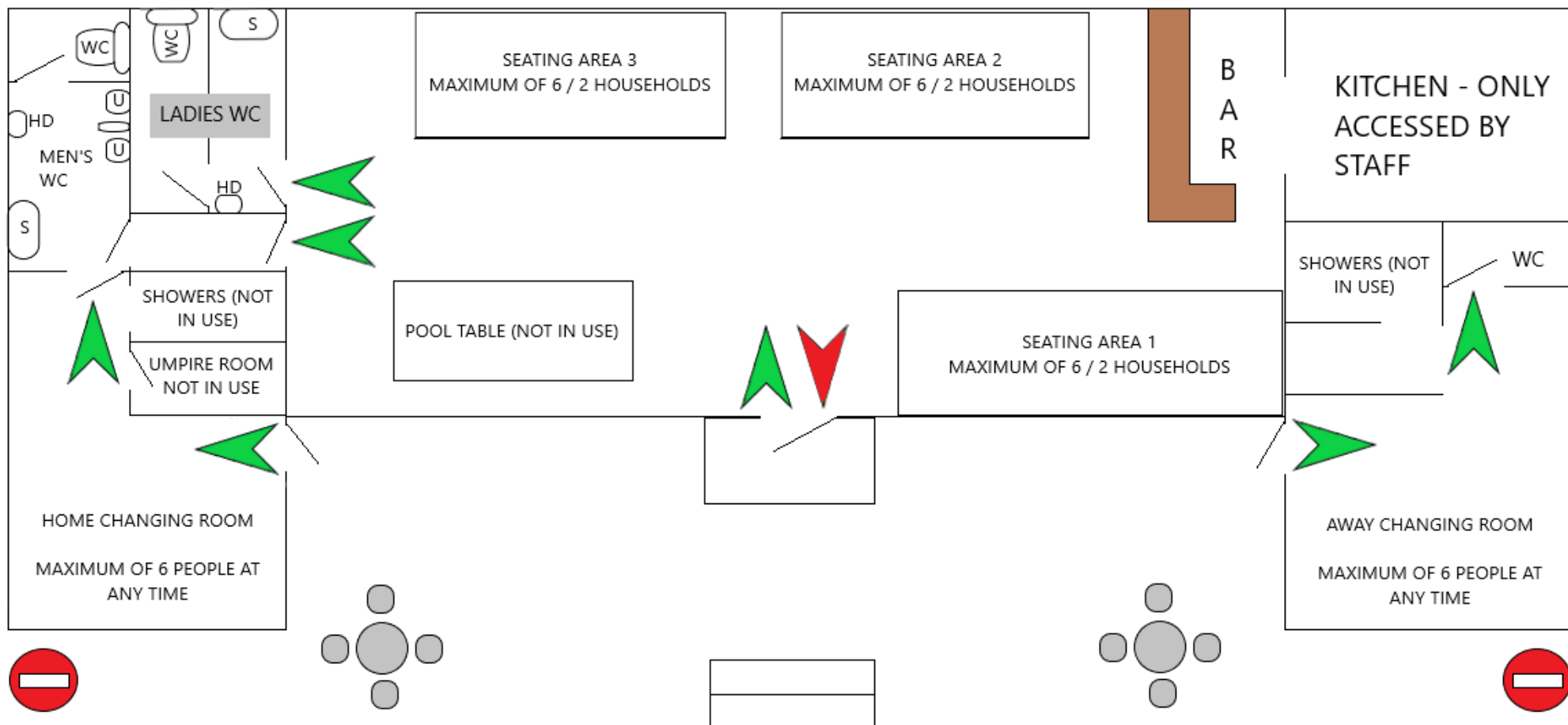
- Any other people at the Club should maintain a distance from the players and officials
- Patrons of the Club's hospitality service will be required to stay seated at their allocated table either inside the Clubhouse or on the Patio Area
- Changing rooms should not be used as shelter during inclement weather. Personal vehicles should still be used in this case.

### **After Match**

- All players and officials should leave the venue as soon as possible after the match (within 30 minutes)
- Any social contact during that time should be conducted with strict social distancing and comply with the Rule of 6 / 2 Households
- Players can, if space allows, partake in the Club's Hospitality Service by being allocated a seat
- All equipment including Stumps, Bails, Balls and Scoreboard should be stored away after sanitisation with Wipes

### **Rules on Hospitality**

- Only members of the Club are allowed to use the services provided
- Members should ask to be allocated a seat by whoever is running the bar service
- They shall remain seated when ordering, being served and consuming their food and drink
- Payment will be taken at the table
- Bar Staff will keep a record of who is using the Bar Service with arrival and departure times



These rules are non-negotiable and are necessary for the Club to comply with Government and ECB Guidance. Any refusal to comply will result in service being withheld and the person(s) being asked to leave the Club premises
